Technical Manager

You ensure that all onsite activities are executed correctly, cost effectively and delivered on time in line with client expectations and quality requirements by planning, directing and coordinating the operations of these activities. You are capable of managing a team of technicians, including taking any necessary disciplinary action and you ensure technicians are assured of their roles and responsibilities.

Your general responsibilities will be:

- Responsible for day to day contact and guidance of the project operations and assignment within the project team;
- Advises on maintenance, repair and, where necessary, determine modifications/improvements to optimize the equipment assets' performance and reliability;
- Responsible for the technical management of assets utilized to all clients and ensures timely follow up on technical and / or project related questions;
- Advises on ad hoc and planned maintenance, repair and modifications in line with quality, environmental and cost requirements as defined by Oceanteam Solutions and clients, such that downtime is kept to an absolute minimum;
- Responsible, from overall technical point of view, for engineering to technical equipment in liaison with third parties;

- Works closely with client's supervisor onsite.
